### Soccer Camp 2009

The Watseka Park District encourages boys and girls, ages 4-13, to join Coach Klaber and his crew for Soccer Camp 2009.

Soccer camp provides participants with a wonderful opportunity to learn basic skills such as passing and dribbling as well as game strategies including proper kicks, scoring and offensive and defensive maneuvers to become a more knowledgeable soccer player.

The soccer camp is set for August 3-6 at the soccer fields located next to the Administrative Center in Watseka. We ask that participants not go inside the Administrative Center during the soccer camp.

Camp is scheduled for children ages 4-9 from 8-9:30a.m. Children ages 10-13 will have camp from 9:45-11:30a.m. Space is limited so early registration is recommended.

Registrations should be submitted to the park district by July 1. T-shirt and soccer balls are included with registration by deadline.

### Youth Fall Soccer Program

The Watseka Park District Youth Fall Soccer program is accepting registrations for the fall soccer season. The soccer program is open to boys and girls ages 4-13. The soccer program provides an opportunity for children to become acquainted with the game and learn and perfect the fundamentals.

Children will practice one night per week and all games will be played on Saturdays. The soccer season is set to begin the week of August 24th with the first games set for August 29th. There will be no games on Saturday, Sept. 5th due to the Labor Day Holiday. The last games for the season will be played on Saturday, October 24.

The soccer program is divided into three **levels. The Mini's are children ages 4-5, Minor's are children ages 6-9 and Majors are children ages 10-13.**

Parents are encouraged to sign-up to be volunteer coaches or assistants. All children will receive a team t-shirt.

Registrations must be received by August 3rd. For more information regarding the soccer program contact the Watseka Park District. The in-district fee is \$35.00 and the out-of-district fee is \$42.00.

## After School Program (ASPA)

ASPA is offered each day after school until 5:00 p.m. at the park district office. The program operates in accordance with the school's calendar year. ASPA is not available when school is not in session.

ASPA is available to children in kindergarten through 5th grades.

The ASPA program offers a nutritious and healthy after-school snack, followed by homework or free reading time and planned activities. Activities focus on enrichment, creativity and recreation. Children engage in arts and crafts, technology, dramatic play, games, music and story time.

Tuition for the ASPA program may be paid weekly, biweekly or monthly; but must be paid on the same timeline for the program duration.
